
Jackie has a degree in Biology from Cal Poly, has been to 6 of the 7 continents, and has been leading conservation focused wildlife tours for over 14 years.

Confiscated

Non-releasable

Archie, a Great Horned Owl, either fell or was pushed out of his nest. At the end of his rehabilitation, he was imprinted on humans and deemed non-releasable.



Owner surrendered

Imagine finding out your son had ordered an alligator over the internet! A package containing Cajun was opened by a very surprised parent. Since alligators can grow to over 8 feet long, Cajun moved to Wild Wonders and joined our other alligator residents.



Rescued

Cezar, a green iguana, was found in a tree with burns over most of his body. It took over a year for him to fully heal.








Camps and Mentoring


Field Trips

- Need to organize a field trip for lots of parents and students? Our recommendations:
 - ▶ Groups of 50 can be broken into two smaller groups of 25, and the tours can be done in parallel.
 - Groups of 100 can be accommodated with 2 groups of 50, with the second group beginning 90 minutes after the first group. For example, the first group of 50 could start at 9:00, and the second group of 50 could start at 10:30.


